

CONSTRUCTION NOISE WAIVER NOTIFICATION SURVEY FORM

Per Chapter 36-6 of the City of Miami Charter and Code, noise from a construction site is prohibited between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. the following day, on weekdays, or at any time on Sundays or Holidays. A noise waiver can be approved by the City Manager or NET (Neighborhood Enhancement Team) Director, as the designee to approve at his discretion any and all Construction Noise Waivers on behalf of the City Manager and the City of Miami.

This waiver is required for extended working hours during the work week, weekends and Federal Holidays. This form shall serve to notify abutting property owners as per the attached exhibit and to provide to the Neighborhood Enhancement Team (NET) office with the list of residents, business, and condominiums affected by the waiver.

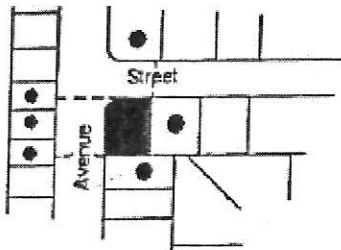

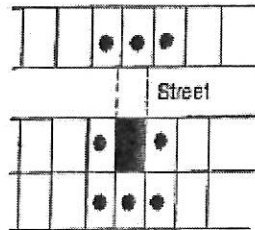
IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHEN FILLING OUT THE NOTIFICATION SURVEY SIGNATURE SHEET

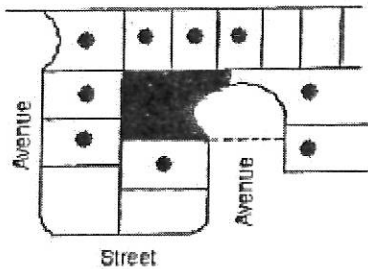
1. All requests for Construction Noise Waiver must be specifically indicated on the notification survey form.
2. The notification survey form page must reflect the applicant's reasons for requesting a Construction Noise Waiver.
3. Notification Survey form must be provided via **Certified Mail only** to all adjacent/abutting neighbors including owners of commercial, Industrial, and residential lots on the Noise Waiver Notification Survey.
4. These depict typical situations which may apply to your lot.
5. **Dots** indicate notification area that is required.



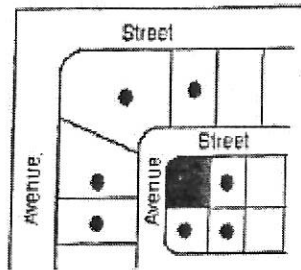

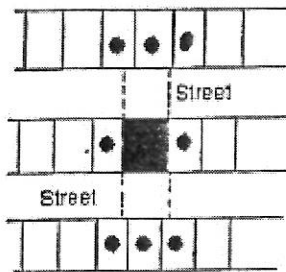

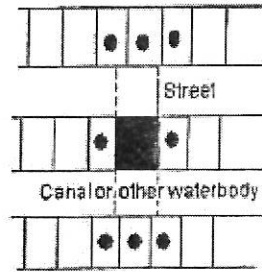
