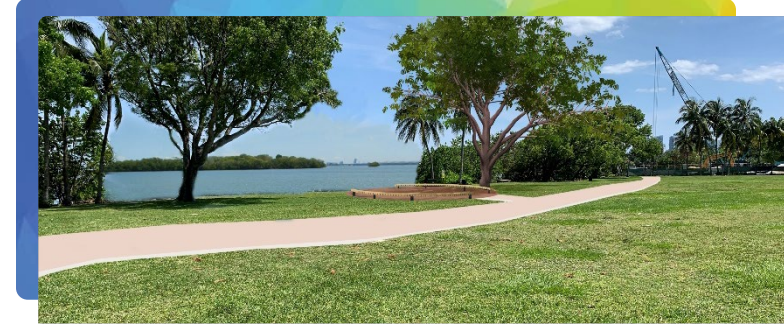

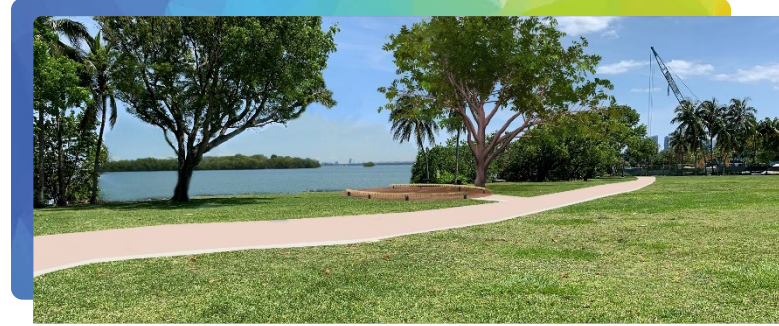

ADA-accessible path. Crushed shell and sand with a binder for a firm path underfoot.



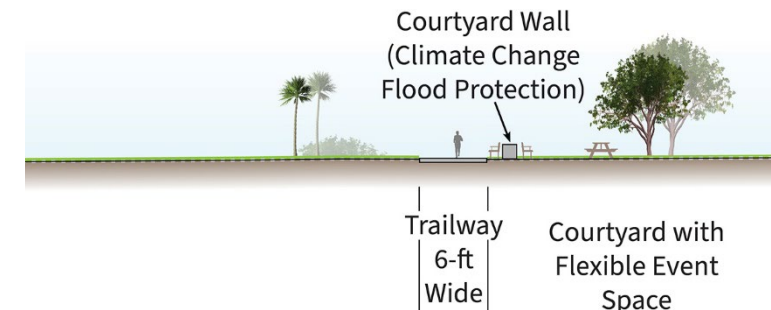
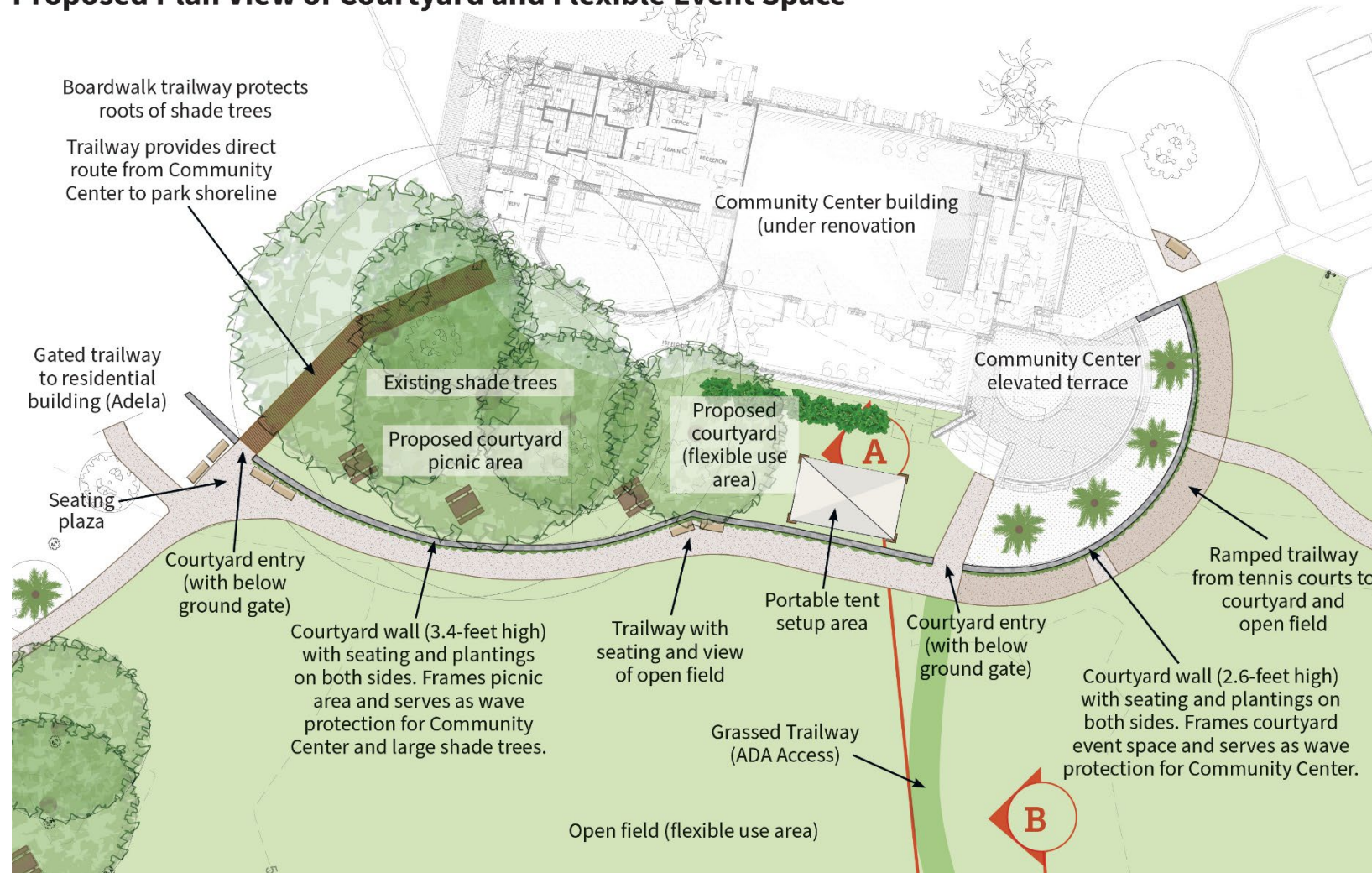

Proposed Plan View of Courtyard and Flexible Event Space

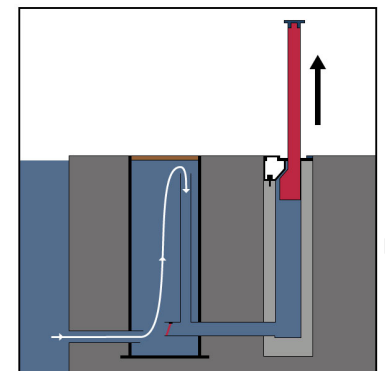
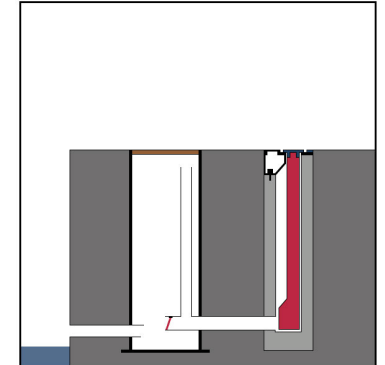


Community Center Courtyard

Courtyard wall includes self-activating gates for flood protection.



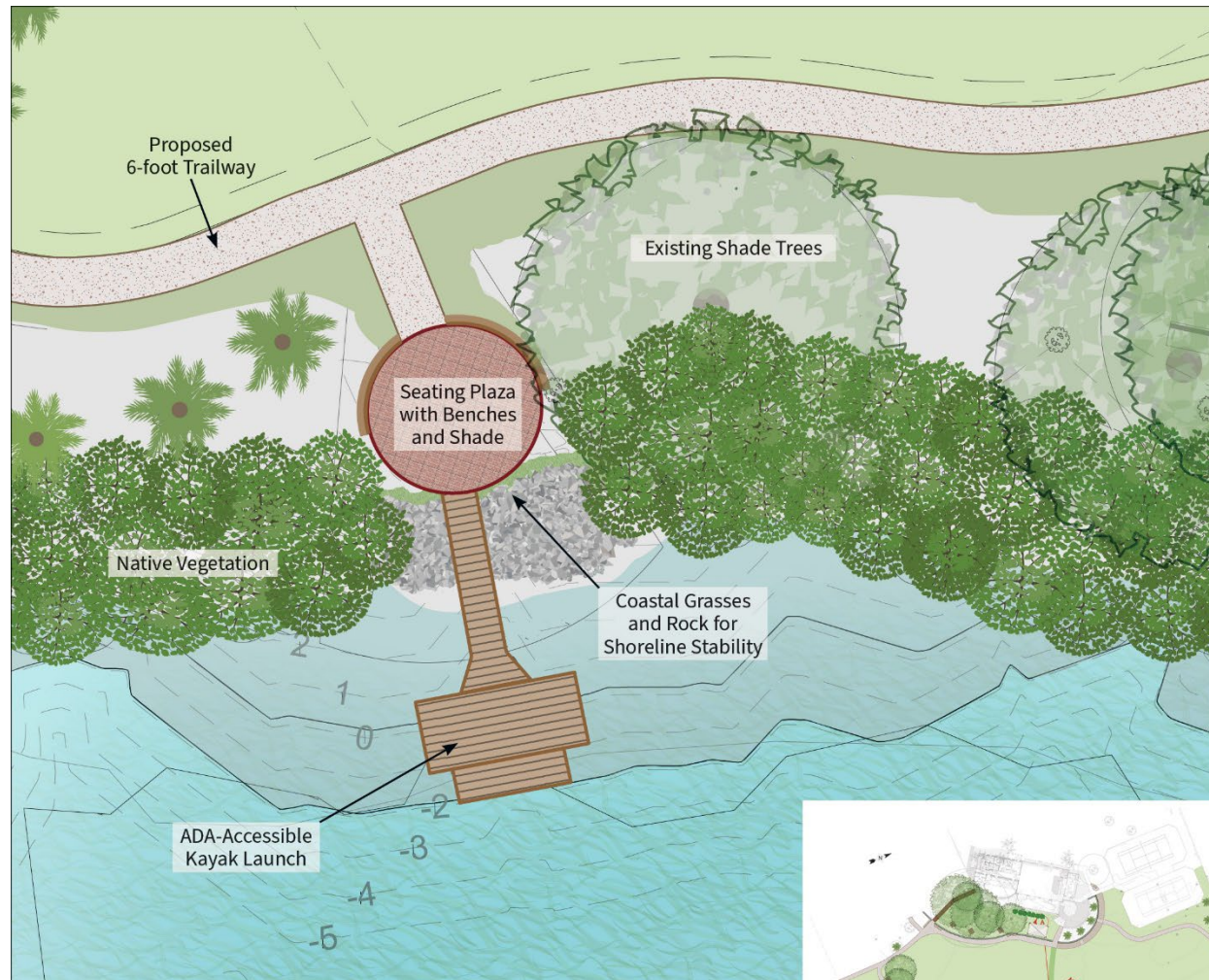

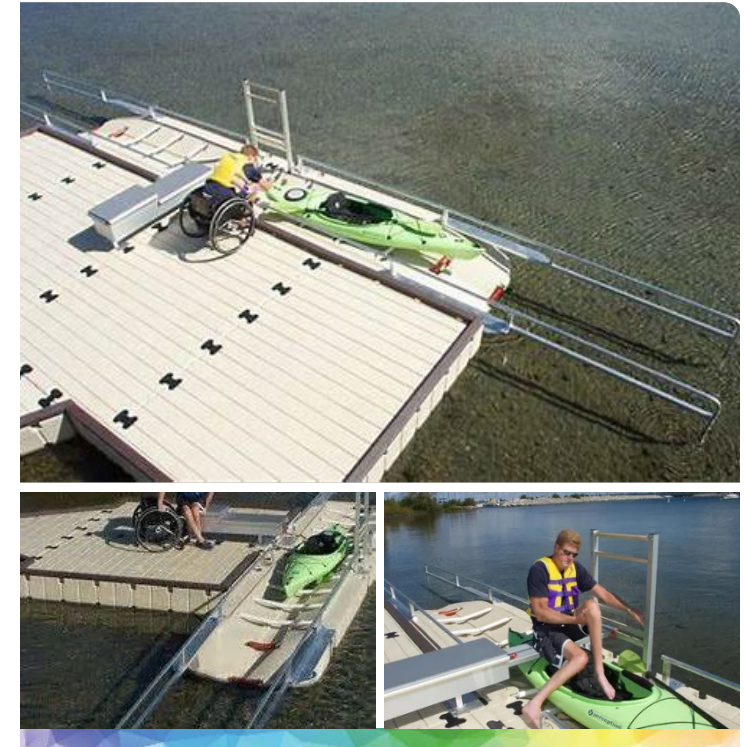

Proposed Plan for Kayak Launch at Seating Plaza with Bay View



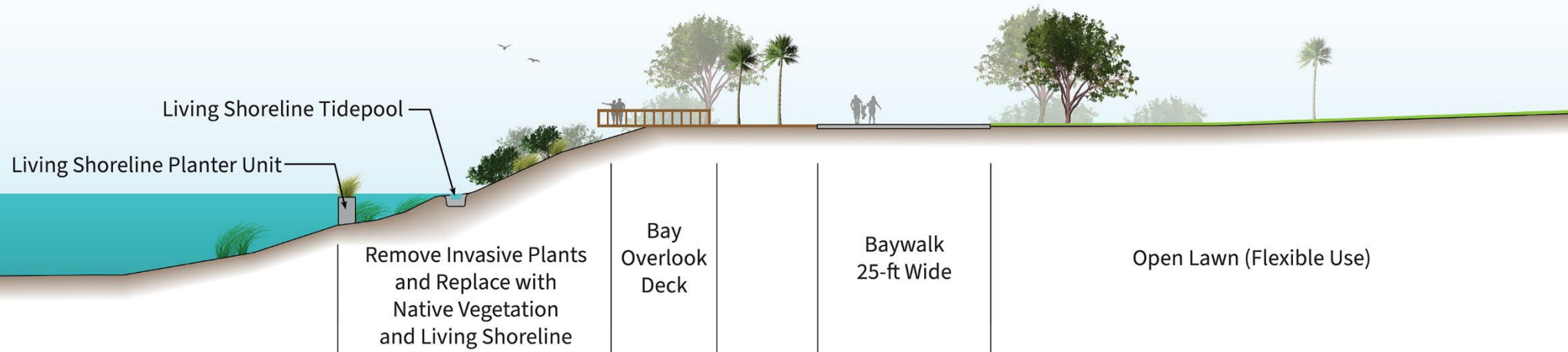

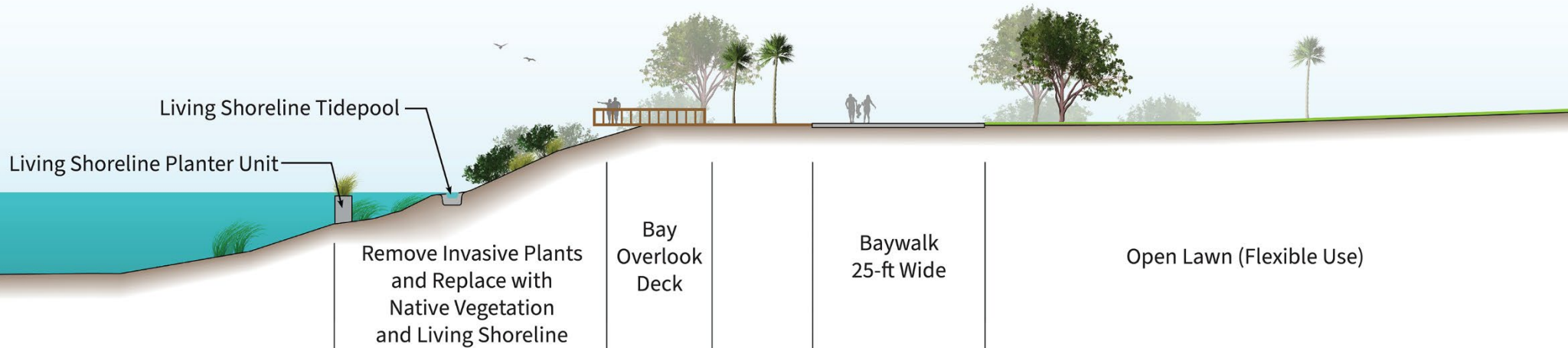
