RE: Margaret Pace Park Shoreline Improvements Phase 1

The Climate Resilience Committee's mission includes reviewing and evaluating issues related to the use, disposition, and development of City-owned waterfront property, and advising the City Commission on those matters.

During the February 3, 2025, Climate Resilience Committee meeting, Hector Badia, Assistant Director of the Capital Improvements Program within the Office of Capital Improvements, presented an update on *Margaret Pace Park Shoreline Improvements – Phase 1*. The project's stated objectives are to enhance shoreline stability and aesthetics, improve public access and recreational opportunities, and incorporate flood mitigation measures through construction of a raised berm and a scenic Baywalk.

Following the discussion, Committee Member Avra Jain made a motion for the Climate Resilience Committee to support Margaret Pace Park Shoreline Improvements – Phase 1, with the following comments for consideration:

- Inclusion of additional Living Shoreline elements; and
- Addition of shade elements through increased tree canopy; and
- Integration of natural path solutions to address pet-related concerns; and
- Support for the use of a berm for flood mitigation.

Committee Member Nkosi Muse seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
