

Standalone Driveway Permit: Applicant Checklist

Required S	Sheets:
☐ Sur	rvey (less than 1 year old). e plan
Both surver Leg Boo Bas	y and site plan need to show information (which must match between survey and site plan): gal description. undary dimensions. se Building Line (BBL). stance to Center Line. right of way conditions (e.g. trees, poles, guy wires, hydrants, curb, gutter, sidewalk, meter xes, fences).
In addition, the site plan must show:	
☐ Dis ☐ Dri ☐ Dri ☐ Vis Cor	proposed driveway location. Stance from edge of driveway to side property line. Siveway width and length. Siveway flares with dimensions Sibility triangle (10' line along BBL, 10' line along driveway edge into private property, and a line nnecting them). pies of relevant Public Works standard details.
	A copy of a boundary survey marked up with proposed driveway may be acceptable as a site so, it must be submitted in addition to a survey without markups.
_ Pul	Inspections: blic Works final inspection. rmwork inspection is optional.
☐ Pul	ll Permits Needed (to be pulled by contractor): blic Works sub-permit. W closure permit.
MoAft	e for express plan check if: ore than 2 dwelling units (bigger than duplex). ter the fact/legalization permit. rmit triggers tree/utility pole relocations (new driveway at location of existing feature).
	ard Materials: Pavers, concrete slabs with spaces in between, and stamped concrete all venants to make property owner responsible for maintenance instead of the City.
☐ Edg ☐ Dri ☐ Slo	ge of driveway at least 5' from side property line. iveway width between 10' and 40'. ope requirements: max 2% cross slope and 5% longitudinal slope for sidewalk, max 8.3% slope to vehicular ramp.
