\*For your information, candidate Mayra Joli submitted qualifying documents that, on their face, are defective and not in compliance with the City of Miami's Charter and Code. Pursuant to Section 16-6(f) of the City Code, when a situation arises whereby the City Clerk finds that candidate qualifying documents, on their face, are defective and not in compliance with the Charter and Code, the City Clerk is authorized and directed to file an appropriate action in the circuit court for Miami-Dade County, in the name of the City Clerk, solely for the purpose of receiving a judicial determination with regard to the qualifications of the candidate. In the event the circuit court rules for the City Clerk, the City Clerk is directed to take the necessary action to remove the name from the ballot or notify the voting public of the candidate's invalidity if such removal is impracticable.

Taking into account the aforementioned information, I will be filing with the circuit court an appropriate action requesting a judicial determination regarding the qualifications of Mayra Joli as a candidate for Mayor.

Additionally, please note that I will be working with the Miami-Dade Elections Department next week on finalizing the ballot for the upcoming election and will forward the finalized ballot to you as soon as it is completed.
